Rules of Conduct ATV's & UTV's

Perry Park Resort

ATV (All-Terrain Vehicles) and UTV (Utility Terrain Vehicles) means a motor vehicle designed to travel over any terrain, of a type possessing between three and six tires and powered by a gasoline engine, but shall not include golf carts.

All property owners must sign this form to bring an ATV or UTV within Perry Park Resort. This set of rules is to protect the property owners, their guests and personal property within the Resort.

Property owners **only** are permitted to drive these vehicles within the Resort. Property owners are permitted to have guests accompanying them. The property owner is responsible for insuring these rules are followed.

This form must be filled out completely and verified by the Security Guard before entering the Resort.

RULES:

- Speed limit is 15 miles per hour.
- You are not permitted to drive an ATV or UTV if you have consumed alcohol or drugs prior to or during driving.
- You must have a valid driver's license in your possession.
- ATV's and UTV's must be safely operated at all times.
- No wheelies, jumps or other stunts are permitted.
- ATV's or UTV's are not permitted on private property without written permission by the owner of the property.
- Loud mufflers on an ATV or UTV are not permitted.
- Automobiles, golf carts, people and animals have the right-of-way at all times.
- No property owner is permitted to drive an ATV or UTV without a form with their name and signature being on file.

Failure to abide by these rules will result in arrest or legal action against the vehicle owner and driver for any damage occurred by that person. You will also forfeit your right to enter an ATV or UTV within the Resort.

This form will remain on file with the Perry Park Resort Owner's Assoc. (PPROA).
