BURN SITE INFORMATION

This is for any burnable items ONLY! Wood or lumber (WITHOUT NAILS OR SCREWS OR ANY KIND OF METAL). Tree logs must be 4-18" n width and no longer than 36". Limbs must be less than 4" width and no longer than 8'. Cardboard must be tied or bundled. CONTRACTORS are prohibited from dumping anything. Burning by authorized personnel only.

- a. Only natural growth trees, trees limbs, brush, weeds, leaves, and grasses are allowed. Dumping of furniture, garbage, leaves, and grasses are allowed. Dumping of furniture, garbage, water heaters, glass, metal objects, appliances, tvs, tires, construction or building materials, is strictly prohibited! Written instructions are also posted at the site.
- b. Contractors are prohibited from dumping anything at the site.
- c. Owen County Dump, in Owenton, will accept any item you wish to dump to that is not burnable at our Burn Site. Their office number is 502-484-2427. You can also sign up for a free Dumping Voucher, for up to 4 times in 1 calendar year, this can be obtained from the court house or online at the Owen County web site.
- d. The burning of garbage is STRICTLY PROHIBITED anywhere within the resort.
- e. OPEN BURNING BANS instituted by Owen County must be observed at all times.
